~Arabian Mounted Native Costume: \$25 (\$500 purse)

~ Dressage Test: \$30/class

~ Event Test (no jumping): \$30/class

~Combined Test: \$40 per division

~Grounds Fee: \$12/d (non-stabled horses)

~Stall Fees (does not include bedding): \$45

~Shavings: \$7 per bag

### Regulations

- 12 month negative Coggins required on all horses.
- All Horses on show grounds must pay either a Stall or per day Grounds Fee.
- All horses on grounds must display an entry number.
- Hunter, Derby, Dressage, and CT classes will be judged following USEF rules. Western, Open, Youth classes will be judged according to AQHA rules.
- Dressage and CT classes must be pre-entered. **Closing Date: Wednesday, 5/17/2017 @ 12 noon.** Contact show secretary to confirm if we can accept a late entry.
- Youth Riders - under 18 years of age as of Jan. 1, 2017.
- No Stallions please.
- Lunging in round pen beside Barn E – ONLY.
- Dogs must be on leash and under control at all times.
- All patterns will be posted day of the show.

- 2 minute gate call will be strictly enforced.
- Scratches must be submitted min. 3 classes in advance or entry fee will be forfeited.
- Tack hold of 5 minutes must be requested min. of 2 classes in advance.
- Management reserves the right to combine classes.
- Proper show attire recommended. Coats for H/J, Dressage & CT optional. Please present neat, clean appearance. Formal Derby Attire recommended but not required.
- ASTM Approved Helmet with harness secured must be worn for all Hunter, Dressage, CT, Derby classes & when mounted at any time on show grounds. Western & Pleasure classes at riders discretion.
- Hunter Over Fences: To be shown over approximately eight fences at required height. Judged on performance, soundness & manners unless otherwise noted. Hunter Courses to simulate fences found in the hunting field. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads as competition warrants.
- Hunter Under Saddle: To be shown at walk, trot & canter. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. May be asked to hand gallop at discretion of the judge but no more than eight to gallop at one time. Martingales not permitted. Green hunter sections will not be asked to gallop.
- Riders in: Starter Division can not cross enter above Green Rider X-rails.
- Riders in Green Rider Division can not cross enter above Hopeful 2'.
- \*\*Novice/Green rider/horse = horse or rider in 1<sup>st</sup> year of competition.
- Hunter/Jumper horses restricted to a total of 2 consecutive divisions per day for the welfare of the horse.
- Hunter Derby: A two round format: First round to be typical hunter classic course set at 2'6", second round to include "handy" type questions. Schooling over fences will not be allowed before the start of derby, hand walking & course walk is permitted. The intent of this class is to provide competitors at the 2'3"-3' hunter/jumper/equitation divisions with the same derby riding experience as offered at national & international levels. Course to be set on a 12' stride. No in and out. \*Horse and rider must have competed in at least 1 other class at 2'3" or higher at this show to qualify for derby. Adults may not ride ponies unless competing on them in a HPIM H/J/ or Eq.
- Pleasure Gait is designated as trot, jog or gaited, no canter.
- Trail Classes: 3 refusals will eliminate competitor.
- Arabian Mounted Native Costume Class: to consist of walk, & canter. May also be asked to halt and backup. Judged on performance, manners & costume. Horses must be under control at all times.
- Any person deemed dangerous or abusive by show management will be asked to leave the show grounds.
- ALL prize monies won will be credited to show bill balance, any prize monies won exceeding the show bill balance will be awarded as a check.
- Judges Decision is FINAL.**
- Neither T. Ed Garrison Arena, nor SCUEC, will be responsible for any losses, accidents or injury.**
